On Friday, 6th June, 2003, the NSW Environment Protection Authority, with the support of the Advanced Manufacturing Centre, is holding a **'Profiting from Cleaner Production'** Forum, followed by Industry Site Tours as part of Western Sydney's Environment Week activities.

The **forum** and **site tours** will provide an opportunity for you and your colleagues to learn first-hand how to increase business profits from cleaner production. You will see and hear how other companies are improving their 'bottom line' by redesigning production processes, reducing resource use (water, energy, raw materials etc), recovering, reusing and selling 'waste' and reducing their waste disposal costs.

You will also learn how a group of 12 companies, supported by the EPA's Industry Partnership Program, have identified cleaner production savings of \$1.3 million per annum.

After lunch we have organised site tours of leading Western Sydney businesses to hear from them how they are saving thousands of dollars each year and reducing their impact on the environment.

At the Forum you will also be invited to join one of 4 cleaner production groups, limited to 10 –15 companies. With the support of the Advanced Manufacturing Centre, companies in these groups will work together to explore opportunities for cleaner production cost savings and improved environmental management.
